### Re: Proposed tougher laws for drivers aged under 25

The Brumby Labor Government has recently announced that it is commencing discussions to consider placing further restrictions and limitations on drivers aged under 25.

The focus of these discussions will be on:

- Tougher laws for drivers aged under 25, including restrictions on night time driving, a reduction in the demerit point threshold, and stricter mobile phone laws;
- Further development and introduction of Intelligent Speed Assist (ISA) technology to forcibly slow down repeat speeding offenders;
- Stronger vehicle impoundment laws, including for repeat drink and drug-affected drivers; and
- Wider use of mandatory alcohol interlock devices.

As your local state member who represents you in parliament, I am keen to know your views on these proposed restrictions (as listed above) and I would encourage you to have your say. It is important to listen to the views of those who could possibly be affected by these restrictions.

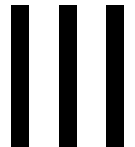
